## Fixed-Route Service

Fixed-route service provides buses that travel the same route in a regular pattern and pick up any waiting passengers. Fixed-route service is a less expensive way to get around and gives you the freedom to travel without arranging a ride in advance.

## Paratransit Service

Paratransit service is a demand-response service where you must reserve a ride in advance. In most cases you must fill out an application with your city to be eligible to ride; each city has its own set of requirements (see below for specifics).
