Basic home maintenance, simple wheelchair ramp construction, and installation of home safety items for seniors and those with disabilities.

Many Hands - Light Work

Basic maintenance services provided by volunteers for those who cannot or should not climb ladders:

- Light bulb replacement with energy-efficient CFL bulbs
- Smoke detector batteries replacement
- Smoke detectors provided if not currently installed
- Furnace filter replacement for most sizes

Weatherization

Program provides increased home energy efficiency and an improved health and safety environment:

- Free before & after energy audit to diagnose a home's performance
- Up to \$600 in energy improvements
- Replacement of primary refrigerator for units over 8 years old
